Rio de Janeiro / Brazil

What is this city known for?

1. Christ the Redeemer (Cristo Redentor)

The monumental 38-meter-high statue of Christ standing atop Corcovado Mountain (710 meters above sea level) is the most recognizable symbol of Rio. The view over the city from this point is breathtaking. You can reach the top by cogwheel train that travels through the Tijuca Forest – the largest urban rainforest in the world.

2. Sugarloaf Mountain (Pão de Açúcar)

This iconic granite peak rises straight from the Atlantic Ocean and offers one of the best panoramic views of Rio. A glass cable car takes you to the summit (396 m a.s.l.) in two stages, with a stop at Urca Hill. A must-see for sunset and landscape lovers.

3. Copacabana Beach

One of the world's most famous beaches – four kilometers of golden sand lined with a promenade featuring the iconic black-and-white wave pattern. A lively hotspot for beach volleyball, coconut water, sunbathing, and soaking in the vibrant spirit of Rio.

4. Ipanema Beach

More refined and local than Copacabana. Immortalized by the song “The Girl from Ipanema”, this beach draws surfers, artists, and residents. From its end point – Arpoador – you can witness one of the most beautiful sunsets in Brazil.

5. Selarón Steps (Escadaria Selarón)

These colorful steps, created by Chilean artist Jorge Selarón, are a true piece of urban art. With 215 steps decorated with over 2,000 ceramic tiles from more than 60 countries, it's not only a major tourist attraction but also a famous backdrop for music videos and photo shoots.

6. Santa Teresa District

A picturesque bohemian neighborhood nestled in the hills, known for its narrow streets, colorful murals, artistic cafés, and the historic tram (bondinho), which still operates. A perfect place to feel the old spirit of Rio and purchase local crafts.

7. Maracanã Stadium

One of the most legendary football stadiums in the world, home to unforgettable matches and the spirit of Brazilian football. Guided tours are available, allowing visitors to see the locker rooms, the field, the stands, and memorabilia from Pelé, Zico, and Ronaldinho. A must-visit for sports fans.

8. Rio's Favelas

Unique hillside neighborhoods full of vibrant houses, murals, and local culture. Visiting places like Rocinha or Vidigal with a local guide offers an authentic insight into the daily life of residents, breathtaking views of the city, and the rhythmic soul of Rio. A powerful experience that blends history, art, and Brazil's social reality.

Rio de Janeiro is a vibrant city where tropical nature meets urban energy and rich culture. Iconic attractions such as Christ the Redeemer, Sugarloaf Mountain, and the famous beaches of Copacabana and Ipanema draw visitors from all over the world. It's a place where each day is filled with music, sunshine, and the unique spirit of Brazilian joy.

Salvador / Brazil

What is this city best known for?

1. Pelourinho – Historic City Center

A colorful colonial district listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, full of cobblestone streets, baroque churches, museums, and galleries. Once a hub of the slave trade, it now pulses with music, dance, and Afro-Brazilian art. A must-visit is the Church of São Francisco with its richly gilded interior.

2. Lacerda Elevator (Elevador Lacerda)

This iconic vertical lift connects the Upper and Lower Town. It's not just a mode of transport but also a panoramic viewpoint over All Saints Bay (Baía de Todos os Santos) and the famous Mercado Modelo – a market filled with souvenirs and local handicrafts.

3. Church of Nosso Senhor do Bonfim

The most venerated sanctuary in Salvador, famous for the colorful ribbons ("fitas") tied to its gates by worshippers making wishes. A place of religio-

us devotion that blends Catholicism with Afro-Brazilian Candomblé spirituality.

4. Forte de Santo Antônio da Barra & Farol da Barra (Lighthouse)

The oldest fort in Brazil, now housing a maritime museum. The lighthouse is a spectacular viewpoint overlooking the ocean, popular with locals and tourists alike for enjoying stunning sunsets.

5. Porto da Barra Beach

One of Salvador's most beautiful beaches, located close to downtown. Sheltered from the waves, its warm, calm waters make it perfect for swimming and relaxing. On weekends, it becomes lively with locals and musicians.

6. Church of São Francisco – A Baroque Masterpiece

Although mentioned earlier, this church deserves its own spotlight. Its interior is covered with over 800 kg of pure gold, making it one of the most impressive baroque structures in South America.



7. Afro-Brazilian Museum (MAFRO)

Located in a former monastery in Pelourinho, this museum showcases African heritage in Brazil – from religion and crafts to music and dance. A must-see to understand the cultural roots of Salvador and the state of Bahia.

Salvador enchants visitors with its colonial architecture, Afro-Brazilian culture, and the magic of the old Pelourinho. It is Brazil's spiritual and musical heart, where daily life moves to the rhythm of capoeira, the scent of dendê oil, and colorful ribbons of faith.

Copacabana / Brazil

What is this place most famous for?

1. Copacabana Beach (Praia de Copacabana)

One of the most iconic beaches in the world – 4 kilometers of golden sand, palm trees, and a famous black-and-white wavy-pattern promenade. It's a place where you can play volleyball, swim, sunbathe, sip fresh coconut water, and soak in the vibrant Rio vibe. Concerts, festivals, and spectacular New Year's Eve fireworks are often held here.

2. Fort Copacabana (Forte de Copacabana)

Located at the southern end of the beach, this early 20th-century military fort offers scenic views of the ocean and Ipanema. Inside, you'll find a military museum and the famous

Confeitaria Colombo café – a perfect spot for coffee with a sea view. A quiet, historical place full of charm.

3. Avenida Atlântica – nadmorska promenada

To serce Copacabany – szeroka aleja spacerowa z deptakiem, ścieżką rowerową, punktami gastronomicznymi i hotelami. Idealna na spacer o wschodzie lub zachodzie słońca. Wieczorami często pojawiają się tu artyści uliczni, tancerze samby i lokalni muzycy.

4. Copacabana Street Market (Feirinha de Copacabana)

Every evening, a market pops up along Av. Nossa Senhora de Copacabana, offering souvenirs, jewelry, paintings, and crafts. It's a great chance to buy local products, meet residents, and

experience the district's authentic vibe.

5. Princess Isabel Monument & Eduardo Kobra Mural

Near Praça do Lido, you'll find a monument to Princess Isabel – a key historical figure in the abolition of slavery in Brazil – and a colorful mural by the famous street artist Kobra. This spot blends history, art, and modern urban culture.

Copacabana is a symbolic district of Rio – with its legendary beach, wave-pattern promenade, and vibrant streets. It's a place where Brazil showcases its energy, joy of life, and cultural rhythm against the backdrop of the ocean.

Búzios / Brazil

What is this place most famous for?

1. Rua das Pedras – The Heartbeat of Búzios

This is the town's main street – lined with art galleries, boutiques, bars, and restaurants. In the evening, it comes alive with music, lively cafés, and clubs that attract both tourists and locals. It's the perfect spot for dinner, a stroll, and soaking in the resort atmosphere.

2. Ferradura Beach (Praia da Ferradura)

A peaceful, horseshoe-shaped beach ideal for families with children. With its warm, calm waters, the beach offers kayak and paddleboard rentals, sun loungers, and dining facilities – making it easy to spend the whole day in comfort.

3. João Fernandes Beach (Praia de João Fernandes)

One of the most famous beaches in Búzios – surrounded by hills, known for its crystal-clear water and excellent snorkeling conditions. Popular among international tourists, it's lined with beachside restaurants serving fresh seafood and fish.

4. João Fernandes Viewpoint (Mirante de João Fernandes)

Just a short walk from João Fernandes Beach, this viewpoint offers stunning panoramic views of the bay, fishing boats, and the blue waters of the Atlantic. A perfect spot for photos, romantic sunset moments, or a quiet break.

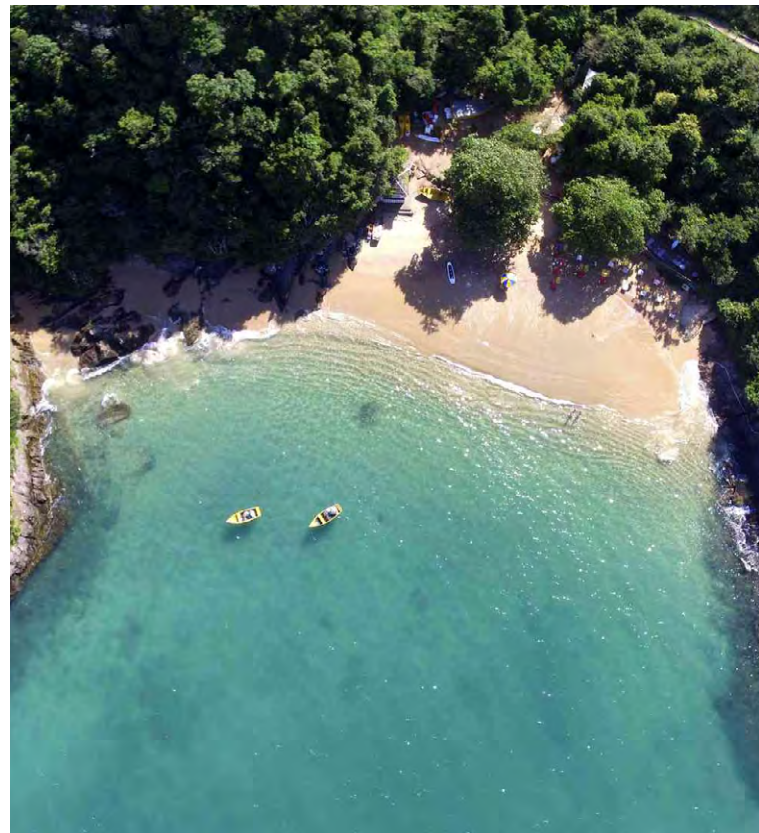
5. Brigitte Bardot Statue and Orla Bardot

French actress Brigitte Bardot made Búzios famous in the 1960s, which led to its

rise as a popular seaside resort. Walking along the Orla Bardot – the town's scenic waterfront promenade – you'll pass her statue, colorful fishing boats, colonial buildings, and feel the artistic vibe of this charming coastal town.

Angra dos Reis / Brazil

1. Ilha Grande – the region's top attraction

An island with no roads or cars, but full of lush jungle, waterfalls, and over 100 beaches. You can hike scenic trails, go diving, relax on beaches like Lopes Mendes (often ranked among the most beautiful in Brazil), or explore historic ruins of an old prison. A perfect destination for nature lovers and those seeking peace.

2. Island hopping (Ilhas de Angra)

Angra dos Reis is surrounded by over 365 islands, many of which can only be reached by boat. Daily tours are available on motorboats (lancha) or larger schooners (escuna), with stops for swimming, snorkeling, and lunch on tropical beaches.

3. Lagoa Azul (Blue Lagoon)

Jedno z najpopularniejszych miejsc do pływania i nurkowania z rurką. Błękitna, przejrzysta woda

One of the most popular spots for swimming and snorkeling. The crystal-clear turquoise waters surrounded by rocky cliffs and lush greenery create a movie-like setting. Perfect for photos and experiencing marine life up close.

4. Lopes Mendes Beach (Praia de Lopes Mendes)

Located on Ilha Grande, accessible by a short hike or by boat, it is considered one of the most beautiful beaches in all of Brazil. With its white sand, turquoise waters, and no buildings in sight, it's a paradise for surfers, photographers, and those seeking serenity.

5. Dentist Beach (Praia do Dentista)

A luxurious yet wild beach on Ilha da Gipóia, popular among private boat owners. Its crystal-clear waters, soft sand, and floating restaurants attract celebrities and travelers looking for exclusive relaxation.

6. Historic Center of Angra (Centro Histórico de Angra)

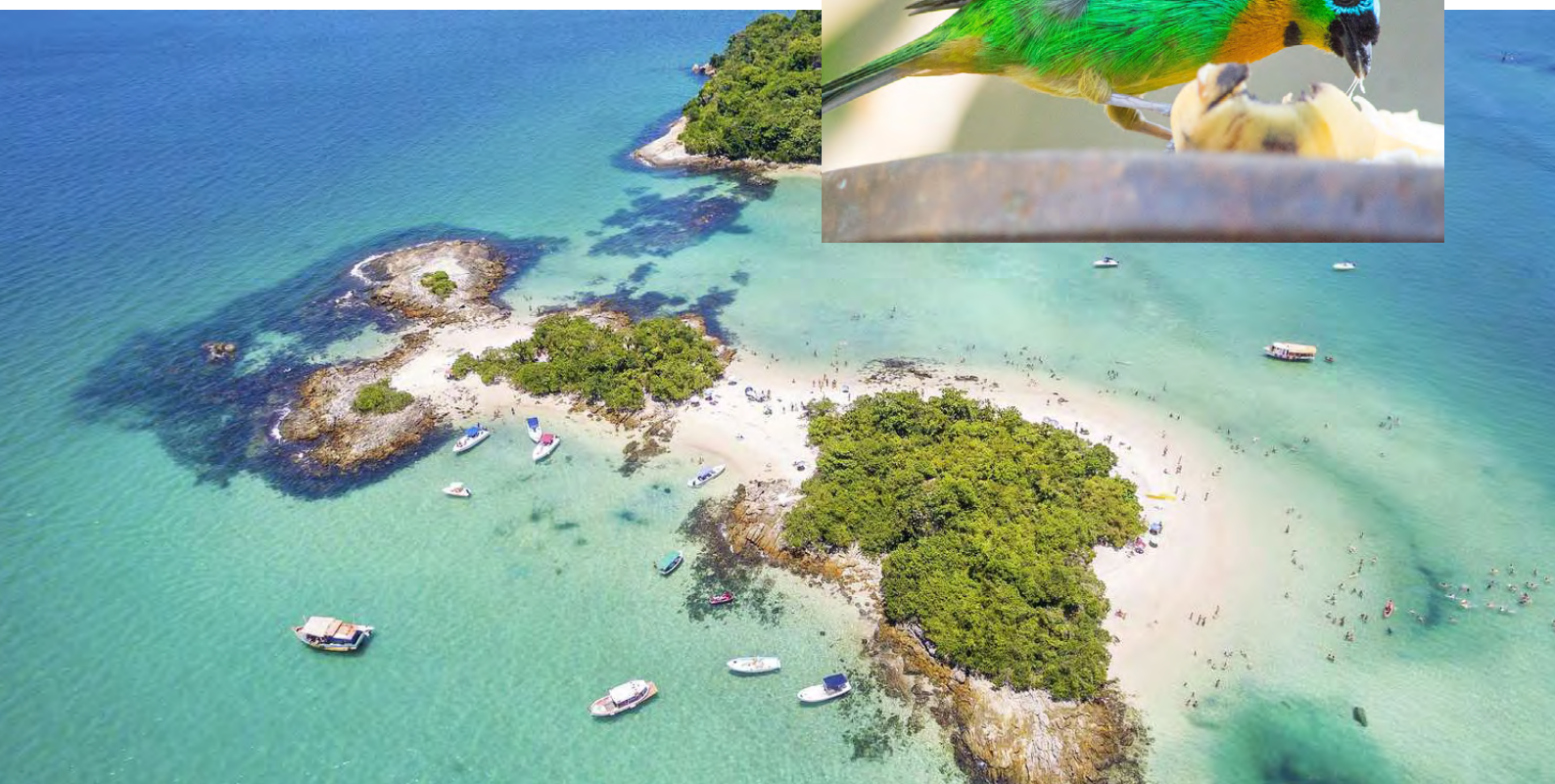

Although the region is best known for its natural attractions, the town of Angra also features a charming colonial center with churches, squares, and buildings from the Portuguese era. A great spot for a short walk and shopping for local products.

7. Waterfalls and Hiking Trails (Ilha Grande / Atlantic Forest – Mata Atlântica)

Across the island and along the mainland coast, there are dozens of hiking trails through the lush Atlantic rainforest. These paths lead to hidden coves, scenic viewpoints, and waterfalls like Feiticeira and Cachoeira da Friagem.

Angra dos Reis is a tropical paradise with over 300 islands, crystal-clear waters, and green hills cascading directly into the ocean. It's the perfect place for island-hopping, beach days, snorkeling, and immersing yourself in unspoiled nature—especially on the magical Ilha Grande. Tranquility, natural beauty, and postcard-worthy bays make Angra the ultimate escape from urban chaos.





Ilhabela / Brazil

What is this destination best known for:

1. Praia do Curral

One of the island's most famous beaches – wide, lively, filled with beach bars, music, and perfect conditions for sunbathing.

2. Cachoeira do Gato (Cat Waterfall)

A spectacular 70-meter-high waterfall hidden in the Atlantic forest. Reaching it requires a short hike, but the reward is a refreshing swim in the natural pool at its base.

3. Parque Estadual de Ilhabela (Ilhabela State Park)

A vast protected area covering most of the

island – ideal for hiking, trekking, birdwatching, and immersing in untouched nature. Entry is only allowed with a guide, ensuring both safety and educational insights.

4. Praia de Castelhanos

A wild beach on the eastern side of the island, accessible only by 4x4 jeep through the jungle or by boat. Considered one of the most beautiful beaches in Brazil – wide, untamed, and perfect for surfing or capturing drone shots. A favorite at sunset.

5. Vila – the island's central town

A charming colonial-style town with a port, small shops, restaurants, and lively nightlife. It's the

cultural and social heart of the island – perfect for dinner or an evening walk after sunset.

6. Cachoeira da Toca

A popular waterfall with a natural rock slide – a great attraction for families and anyone looking for a bit of adventure in nature.

7. Bonete Beach (Praia do Bonete)

One of the most remote and authentic beaches on the island, accessible by foot (about 12 km of trekking through the forest) or by boat. Surrounded by mountains

and a small fishing village – perfect for those who seek peace and wild beauty.
