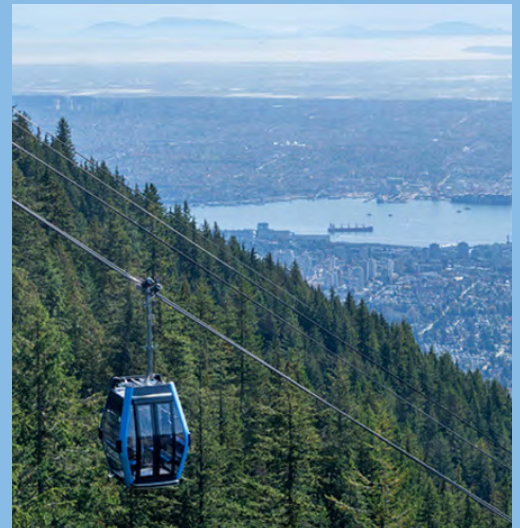
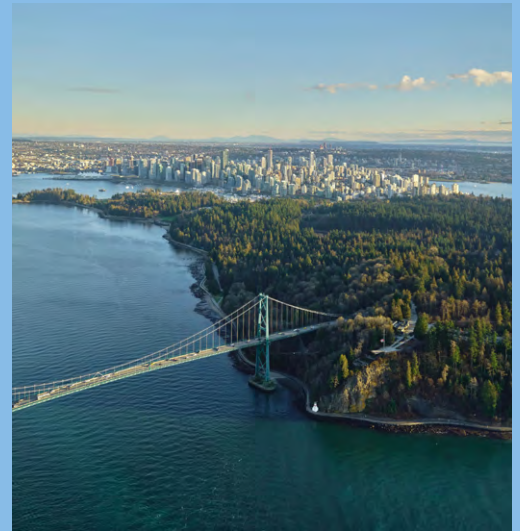

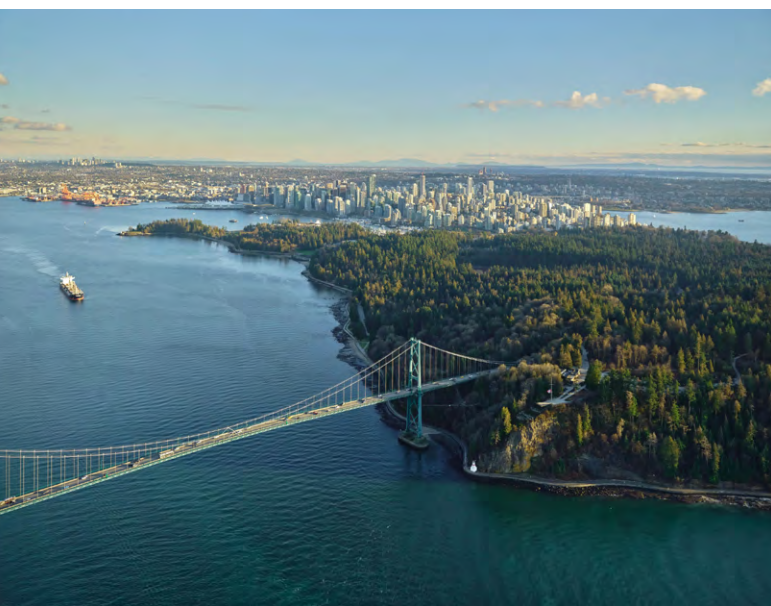
you can enjoy one of the most beautiful panoramas of Vancouver. Visitors can also see wildlife shows and dine at restaurants overlooking the ocean.

Juneau (Alaska) / USA

The Mendenhall Glacier is a 20-kilometer-long natural wonder located just a few kilometers from downtown Juneau. The area features scenic viewpoints, hiking trails, and an informative visitor center. One of the most iconic sights is the glacier reflected in the lake at its base — a true symbol of Juneau and an absolute must-see attraction.

2. Whale Watching

Juneau is one of the best places in North America for observing humpback whales and orcas. Tours operate from late spring through fall and almost always guarantee successful sightings. 3. Mount Roberts Tramway

Skagway / USA

Skagway is a small, picturesque town located on a narrow peninsula in Alaska, surrounded by mountains and fjords. Although it has a population of only about one thousand residents, it welcomes hundreds of thousands of cruise ship visitors each year. The town has preserved its unique atmosphere from the late 19th-century gold rush era.

The city is best known for:

1. White Pass & Yukon Route Railway

This is Skagway's most famous attraction — a historic railway line that winds through steep mountain slopes. The scenic train ride offers breathtaking views of cliffs, waterfalls, and wild valleys. Built during the Klondike Gold Rush, the route remains an engineering marvel to this day. It's an absolute must-see for every visitor.

2. Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park

This park and open-air museum tells the story of the gold seekers who set out from Skagway toward the Klondike. Its exhibits vividly depict the hardships and daily life of pioneers during the late 1800s. Many of the downtown buildings have been preserved in their original style. It's a place where history truly comes to life.

3. Chilkoot Trail

This legendary trail once served as the main route for prospectors traveling to Canada during the gold rush. Today, it's one of the most famous historic trekking routes in North America. Even hiking a short section allows visitors to experience the spirit of the early adventurers who

crossed these wild mountains. It's a perfect destination for nature lovers and outdoor enthusiasts.

4. Skagway Historic District

The town's preserved, colorful wooden buildings create the atmosphere of an authentic gold rush settlement. In the historic center, you'll find artisan shops, museums, bars, and saloons designed in 19th-century style. A walk along Broadway, the main street, feels like stepping back in time. It's an ideal spot for atmospheric photos and a leisurely stroll.

5. Mountain Viewpoints and Hiking Trails Nearby

The area around Skagway offers numerous short trails leading to viewpoints overlooking fjords and snow-capped peaks. These routes provide an opportunity to connect with nature, away from the busy tourist streets. Trails range from easy walks to more challenging hikes, with spectacular views that reward every step.

Glacier BAY (Scenic Cruise) / USA

Glacier Bay National Park (Alaska, USA) is one of the most magnificent natural sites in the entire Northern Hemisphere. The park lies in a rugged, glacial landscape where massive ice tongues meet the ocean. It is a realm of silence, towering mountains, turquoise waters, and spectacular ice cliffs that occasionally break off with a thunderous crash and plunge into the sea. The best way to admire Glacier Bay is from a cruise — only from the ship's deck can you fully experience its true beauty up close.

What is the Glacier Bay cruise experience like?

During the voyage, ships slowly sail deep into the fjord, passing a series of glaciers descending from the mountains directly into the ocean — the so-called tidewater glaciers. The highlight is often the monumental Margerie Glacier, whose vertical ice wall rises more than 30–50 meters above the water's surface. From time to time, passengers can witness “calving” — the spectacular breaking off

of ice blocks that crash into the sea with a thunderous roar. Throughout the journey, the scenery looks more like Antarctica than North America.

Wildlife in Glacier Bay

A cruise through Glacier Bay is also an encounter with untamed nature in its purest form. In the waters, you can spot whales — including humpbacks and orcas — as well as sea lions, seals, and sea otters. Along the shores, bears and mountain goats are often seen. Above the fjords, golden eagles and bald eagles circle majestically, adding to the park's wild grandeur. For nature lovers, this is a true paradise — alive, authentic, and virtually untouched by humankind.

Interesting facts about Glacier Bay

- Glacier Bay is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the world's most significant glacial parks.
- Two hundred years ago, the entire bay was almost completely covered by ice — today, ships can sail up to 100 km deep into the fjord.
- The ice in some of the glaciers is between 200 and 1,000 years old, and its turquoise color comes from the immense pressure that formed it.
- It is one of the quietest places in the United States, protected by strict noise regulations — even cruise ships must follow rules minimizing their environmental impact.

A voyage through Glacier Bay is not just an attraction but an experience that stays with you for a lifetime. The raw, icy world, dramatic cliffs, cracking ice, and wild nature create a setting unlike anywhere else in America. It is one of those rare places that reveal the true power of nature and inspire deep respect for its majesty.

Ketchikan (Alaska) / USA

Ketchikan is a picturesque town on the southern coast of Alaska, surrounded by mountains and the waters of the Pacific Ocean. Known as the “City of Totems,” it is one of Alaska’s most frequently visited cruise ports. The town offers a unique blend of Native heritage, Gold Rush history, and the breathtaking landscapes of fjords and rainforests.

What the city is best known for:

1. Totem Bight State Historical Park

The park features an impressive collection of historic and reconstructed totem poles created by Alaska’s Indigenous peoples, including the Tlingit, Haida, and Tsimshian tribes. Visitors can explore traditional clan houses and learn about the history and symbolism behind each carving. A walk through the park allows you to experience the spiritual and artistic richness of this cultural site — a must-see for anyone interested in Native Alaskan heritage.

2. Creek Street

This historic street in Ketchikan, built on wooden stilts over the water, once served as the town's red-light district and center of entertainment. Today, it is home to charming shops, art galleries, cafés, and restaurants offering local delicacies. A walk along its wooden boardwalks feels like stepping back in time to the Gold Rush era. 5. Saxman Totem Park

It's a place that offers a deeper understanding of the heritage and artistry of Alaska's Indigenous peoples.





Seattle / USA

Seattle is the largest city in the state of Washington, beautifully situated between Lake Washington and Puget Sound. 4. Discovery Park

Discovery Park is Seattle's largest green space, offering more than 11 kilometers (7 miles) of walking trails. It features sandy beaches, forested paths, and a stunning viewpoint overlooking Puget Sound. It's the perfect place to escape the bustle of the city and reconnect with nature. Each season brings new colors, scents, and experiences to this urban oasis.

5. Seattle Aquarium i Waterfront

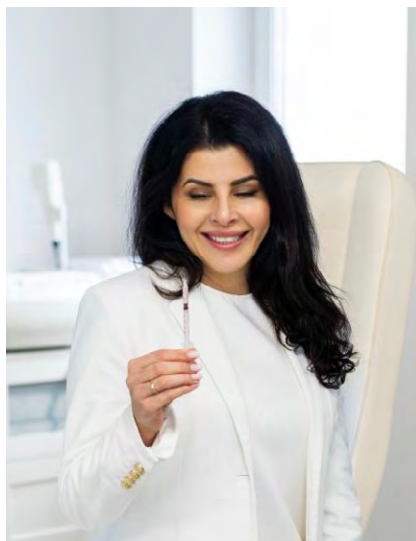
